

March 23rd is the date for our annual cleanup in preparation for our open houses, starting at 9am, and we usually work until noon. We ask that people working outside bring rakes, clippers, work gloves, etc. Inside cleaners need to bring some cleaning supplies, vacuum or broom, windex, paper towels and whatever else they like to use.

If the weather on the 23rd is not conducive to be outside the inside cleaning could still proceed and we would push the outdoor activities to April 6th (which is the day before our first open house).

2024 Open Houses

Open houses resume in April. Open Houses are held the first and third Sundays of each month from April through October. Our buildings are open from 1-3. The history of Butler Township and Vandalia will be featured in April. We will have a brief summary of how the township was formed and grew. The earliest residents were Native Americans. Several different Indian tribes once lived and hunted in our area. You will be able to view a collection of their artifacts found buried on Butler Township Farms. You can learn about the first Log Home built in the township, view maps of our area from the 1800's and see pictures of some of our earliest businesses.

Army Field Desk

One of our goals at the Historical Society of Vandalia Butler is to change our displays monthly. We hope that you will visit often and learn something new each time you visit. We have an Army Field Desk from the Civil War that we have featured in our displays. We recently rediscovered a World War I Army Chief Engineer Field Desk. This desk was built by the American Lawn Mower Company of Muncie, Indiana in 1918. American Lawn Mower Company is still in business, now in Indianapolis. The company continues to make reel lawn mowers as part of their line of lawn care products. The company built a limited number of field desks in 1917 and 1918. At that time, the company had some talented woodworkers and these men made an intricate drawer and cubby system inside each desk. Unfortunately, the drawers and shelves are missing from our desk. It will be on display later this year.
