Historical Society of Vandalia-Butler September - October 2025 Newsletter

We are less than a year away from celebrating the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. Activities across the country have already started, including the State of Ohio. Here is some information that may help you in getting involved in the celebrations.



About the America 250-Ohio Commission

The Ohio Commission for the U.S. Semiquincentennial (also referred to as America 250-Ohio) was formed through the OH. Rev. Code \$ 149.309 and announced on March 1, 2022, on Ohio's Statehood Day by Governor Mike DeWine. The 29 member commission is charged with preparing the state to participate in the United States of America's 250th anniversary which culminates on July 4, 2026.

America 250-Ohio is a multi-year commemoration where Ohioans from all 88 counties will be in the spotlight of the impact Ohio's unique role in our nation's story.

Ohio and Ohioans have contributed much to the United States from statesmen to artists, from actors to Nobel laureates, and so much more. We will tell the story of Ohio. from the Native Americans who were here before Europeans to people who call Ohio home today. Ohio is a content-rich environment for anyone who wants to commemorate and celebrate Ohio's contributions to national stories.

Do you have a **Revolutionary War ancestor** who was buried in Ohio? The Ohio Sons of the American Revolution's database lists all known Revolutionary War soldiers who were buried in Ohio. You can check it out at ohssar.org. On the menu bar at the top of the page, click on **More** then **Links** then **OHSSAR Patriot Database**. Scroll down the list to look for your Revolutionary War ancestor.

September and October Open Houses

September open houses are Sunday, September 7 and Sunday September 21. In September, we will feature items from our America at War collection. On display will be the desk of Vandalia resident and Civil War Captain Walter Crook. Also featured will be Vandalia resident H. H. Cassel and the Bible he found on a Civil War battlefield. We have a Chief Engineer's desk from World War I and ration books, uniforms, and other books and articles from World War II. Retired American History teacher Lonnie Hathaway will be at the September 7 open house to answer questions about the Civil War.

October open houses will be Sunday, October 5 and Sunday, October 19. In October, we will look back at the changes in Vandalia-Butler Schools. We will start in 1900 when many schools were one room, subscription schools. We will jump ahead 1925 when schools became centralized and high school boys were paid \$1.00 a day to be bus drivers. They were not allowed to drive faster than 15 mph. The 1950's brought more elective courses and extracurricular activities. This was a time of rapid population growth. The Field House (called the Pit) was opened and Vandalia added elementary schools. We will jump ahead to the years 1975 and 2000, years that benefited from changes in technology. Visit the Meeting House to see old pictures, programs, yearbooks and school memorabilia.

Mystery Picture

The Civil War Bible that H. H. Cassel found on a Georgia battlefield was stored in the Historical Society's archive room on top of a small box. The box contained a small framed photograph of a Civil War soldier. There was no identification with this photograph. Vandalia resident and Civil War scholar Phil Spaugy and retired American History teacher Lonnie Hathaway carefully opened the frame, but there was no identification on the back of the photograph. Phil Spaugy scanned the photo to search for a match in the data base of known Civil War soldiers. Facial recognition technology did not find a match. The photo is now in a data base and we hope there will be a future match with an identified picture.
